

Course Description: Foreign Language — Latin I

1 Credit

This hybrid course uses video, worksheets, and extensive practice through reading, viewing, hearing, flashcards, quizlets, and speaking. Each of the 30 lessons includes 3 videos, 3 worksheets, and a quiz. The student will also read all of Cornelia , the first half of Lingua Latina, and the Gospel of John in Latin as part of this 1.0 credit course.
